Greetings from the German Engineering Federation (VDMA)

India's manufacturing exports for FY21–22 reached an unprecedented USD 418 billion, an overall growth of more than 40% compared to the USD 290 billion from the previous year. **India** exported machinery worth USD 4.98 billion to Europe in 2021 which was an increase of 52% from the previous year. The top 5 sectors of Indian machinery exports to Europe were Power transmission engineering, Construction equipment and building material machines, Power systems, Valves and fittings, Compressors, compressed air and vacuum technology. The top 5 countries of Indian machinery exports to Europe were Germany, United Kingdom, Italy, France and Turkey.

The sharp rise in exports last year has been on the back of a significant increase in share of manufacturing in the country's exports. India is expected to scale up its manufacturing exports to USD 1 trillion by FY28, and much of this growth will come from Chemical, Pharma, Industrial Machinery, Electrical & electronics, Automotive, and Textile & apparel sectors. India's exports have seen tremendous growth over the last two years, with a compound annual growth rate (CAGR) of 15%, rebounding from 5-10% in the pre-pandemic years.

Global sourcing is moving from being a strategic advantage to a competitive necessity. Fierce competition has seen many companies source from low-cost countries. Investor expectations of higher returns on investment, combined with increased competition, are driving organizations to reduce costs and expenditure for an immediate and direct impact on the bottom line. At the same time, they are challenged to maintain service levels and prevent any loss of control. Manufacturing activities in India remained robust and price pressures were contained in October 2022 as new orders and production rose at a slower but stronger pace. For European companies also, this disruption is a wake-up call to decouple the risk and look at alternate supply chain and manufacturing possibilities. In India, we are seeing an increased interest of the European companies to enhance their existing presence in Indian market through sourcing as well as looking at the Indian operations as "Center of Excellence" and manufacturing some range of products here for the global market.
