WHERE IS THE CONSTRUCTION EQUIPMENT SECTOR GOING?

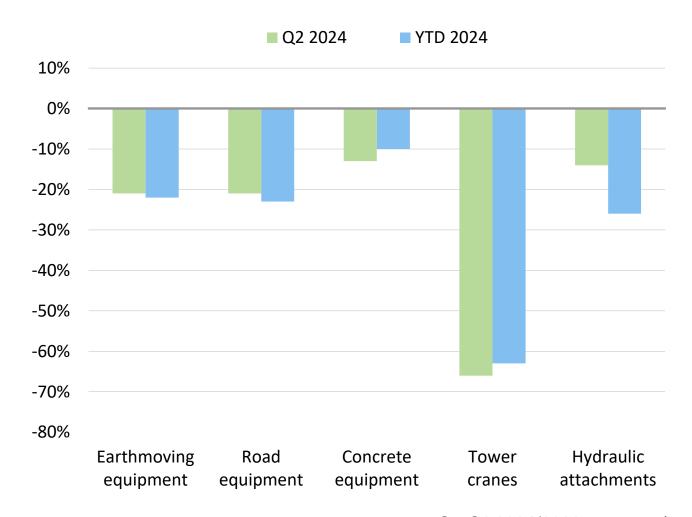
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Strong downturn in all equipment sub-sectors



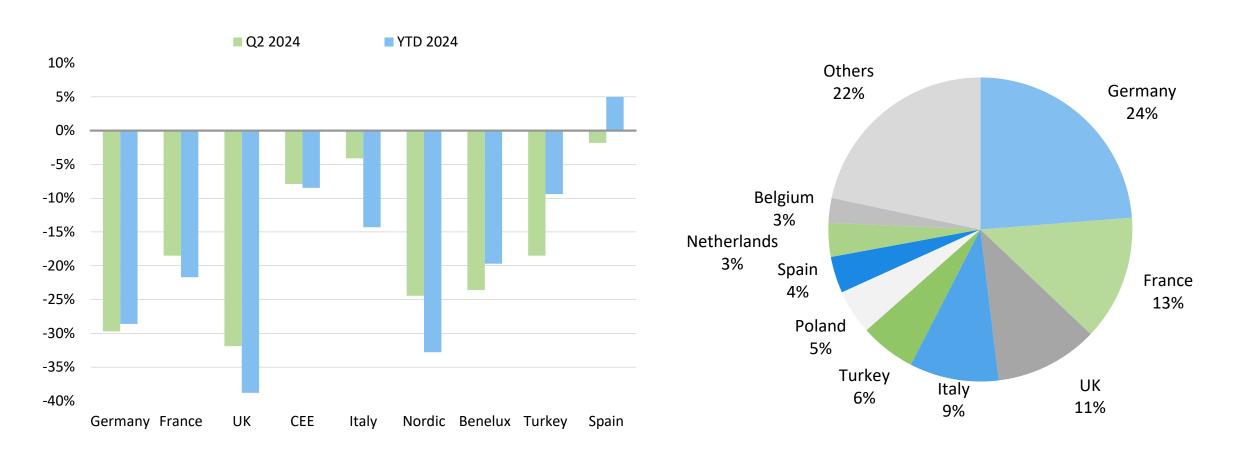


Q1-Q2 2024/2023 construction equipment sales, source: CECE



Declines even in CEE and Southern Europe

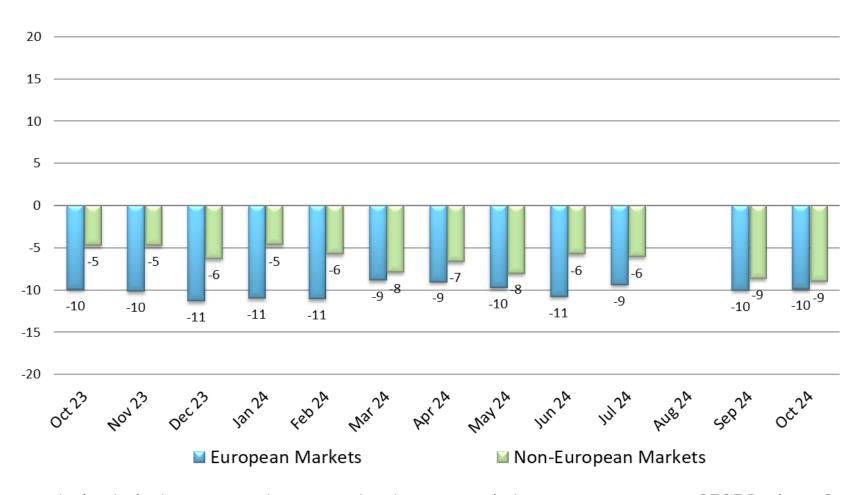




Q1-Q2 2024/2023 construction equipment sales, country shares of European total, source: CECE

Incoming orders still on a downward trajectory

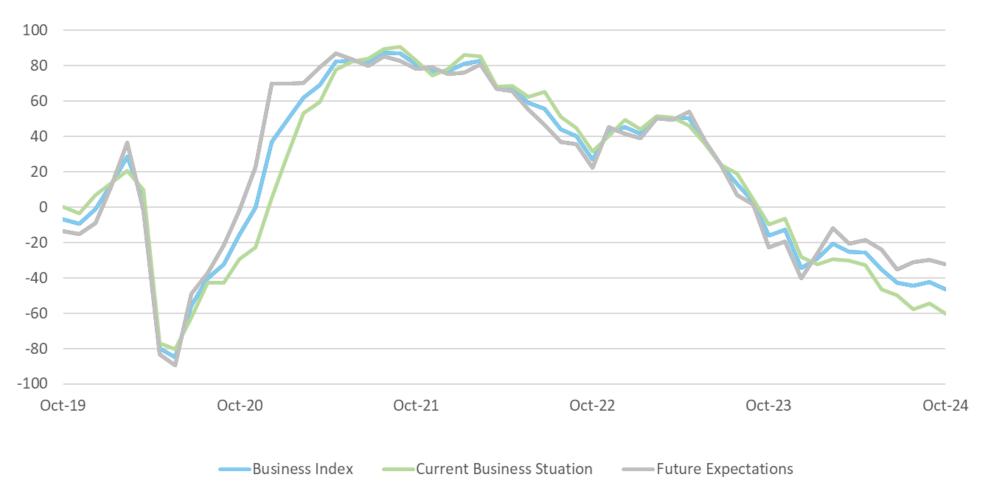




new order intake in the past month compared to the same period one year ago, source: CECE Business Barometer, October 2024

Waiting for an upturn of business climate

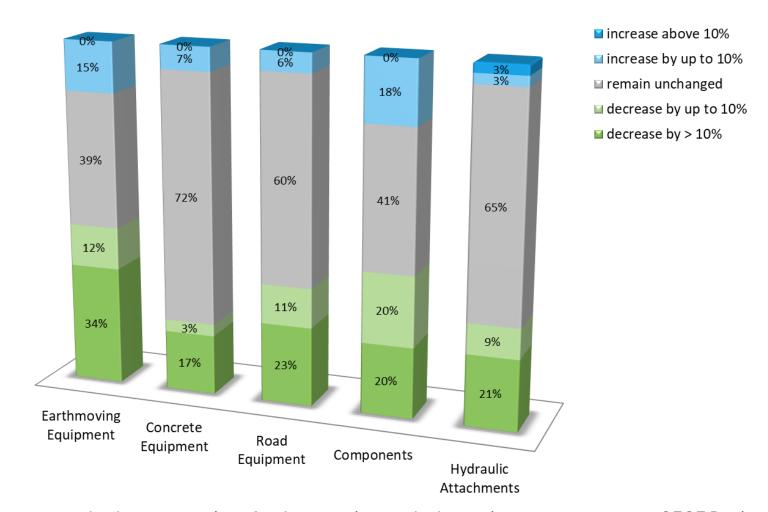

Concrete machinery makers least pessimistic

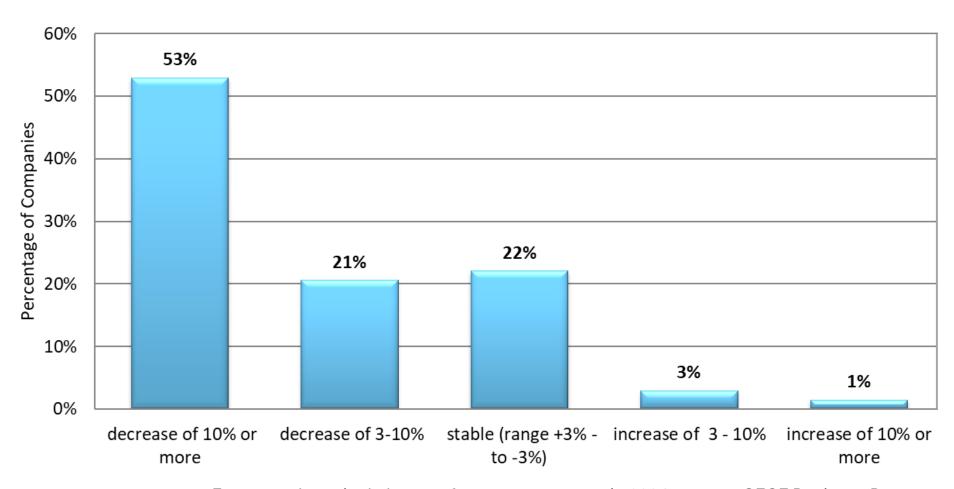




total sales expectations for the next six months by equipment type, source: CECE Business Barometer, October 2024

CECE members: company turnover forecast



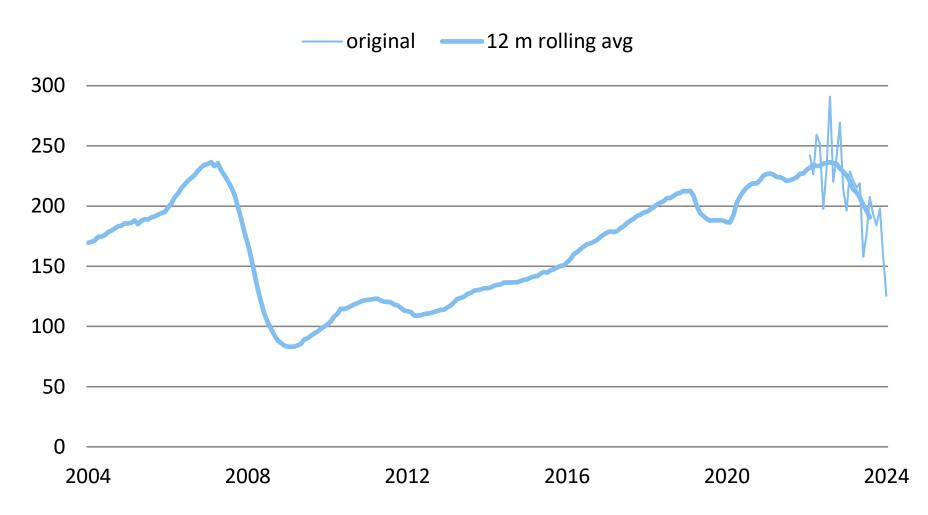


Forecasted nominal change of company turnover in 2024, source: CECE Business Barometer, October 2024



So what about good news? Still high market levels...

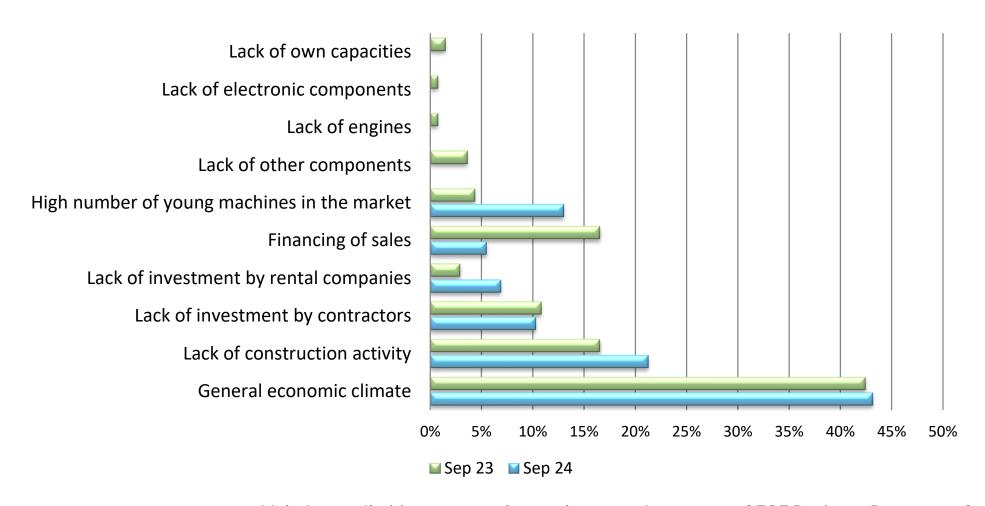




monthly construction equipment sales in Europe, last data point: August 2024, index 2010 = 100

...no supply-side bottlenecks...





Main factors limiting construction equipment sales, source: CECE Business Barometer, September 2024

...and maybe a return to growth mid-2025.



In a nutshell:

- Current downturn goes far beyond (residential) building construction equipment segment
- All European market regions have recently turned negative
- Rates of declines might get smaller in Q4 thanks to a statistical base effect
- Still, a 20% sales decline on the European market in 2024 seems inevitable
- Replacement investments could kick in next year, particularly in the rental industry
- Austerity likely to be back after many years of stimulus spending, but demand for infrastructure investments continues to be high in many European regions
- Energy transition efforts will back equipment demand
- But: High economic uncertainty due to geopolitical situation
- 2025 sales in Europe: 0 to -5%
- Mixed outlook for European equipment exports
